WELCOME AND THANK YOU FOR INCLUDING HEAD-SMASHED-IN BUFFALO JUMP IN YOUR TRAVEL PLANS. HERE ARE GUIDELINES TO ASSIST YOU IN PREPARATION OF YOUR VISIT:

- All groups must book a minimum of 24 hours in advance to qualify for group rates
- Payment is due upon arrival and must be made in one payment. We accept Visa, Master Card, American Express, debit, cash and cheques (payable to "Government of Alberta")
- Cancellation policy: all cancellations must be received 3 days prior to arrival or groups will be charged the full amount (no charge outside of 3 days). Please call 403.553.2731

- In order to maximize your guests experience many groups include the services of one of our Blackfoot Guides. A non-commissionable Guide Fee of \$50 (including GST) per group is available to all pre booked groups. A Blackfoot guide will provide your group an orientation and a guided facility tour. The tour usually last 1.5 hours
- Our centre is wheelchair accessible. We have a limited number of complimentary wheelchairs available
- There is no ATM on site, we accept cash, debit or credit both in the gift shop and admissions
- Friendly reminder: Our Centre is a public facility therefore there may be other groups in the building including school groups. Courtesy to others is appreciated.
- Every Wednesday in July and August on the plaza, witness some of Western Canada's best First Nations dancers perform to the beat of Blackfoot drumming and singing. Two performances daily: 11 am and 1:30 pm
